**WHEREAS**, Minnesota has traditionally led the nation in quality education, renowned for its continual commitment, progressive methods, and successful results; and

**WHEREAS**, the state's best schools have shown superiority of organization, leadership, curriculum instruction, student outcomes, character development, school climate, and school and community relationships; and

**WHEREAS**, the state has set a goal of a 90 percent high school graduation rate by 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ellsworth Public School District now has a 100 percent high school graduation rate, exceeding the state goal of 90 percent and the state average of 82.7 percent; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate of the State of Minnesota that it commends the administration, staff, students, and parents at the Ellsworth Public School District for their efforts in attaining a 100 percent high school graduation rate.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Secretary of the Senate is directed to prepare an enrolled copy of this resolution, to be authenticated by the Secretary's signature and that of the Chair of the Senate Rules and Administration Committee, and transmit it to the board of the Ellsworth Public School District.
